

Annual Education Report (AER) Holt Junior High School

Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER), which provides key information on the 2021-22 educational progress for Holt Junior High School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. If you have any questions about the AER, please contact Principal Dominic Knighten for assistance.

For the 2021-22 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that had at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2018-19. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that had a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2017-18. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance was in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or had a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2016-17. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given.

Our school has been labeled as an Additional Targeted School (ATS).

At Holt Junior High School, our data shows low proficiency in ELA and Math for our BIPOC, Economically Disadvantaged, and Special Education students. Lack of growth, reflected through data points such as NWEA and proficiency on MSTEP, continues to place an emphasis on how we're better using the data in order to improve our supports. For example, we have added a resource room for students on caseload, as well as an after school help room for all students for ELA and Math. Students are still on teams, and teachers on those teams share common planning periods, so being able to use the data to work collaboratively during that time to find supportive paths will continue to be a focus. Through department time, too, our teachers are working to put their lessons/units onto the Atlas platform.

Our district and building work regarding equity and inclusion is a major focus. We continue to educate our staff and engage in conversations around culturally relevant pedagogy and restorative practices during our professional develop and staff meetings. Students are also involved twice a week in RAM Time, which provides opportunities for community building, and also brings more awareness to areas of growth for our building, and how to address them in a culturally appropriate and restorative manner.

State law requires that we also report additional information.

All student are assigned to schools based on a physical address within neighborhoods. Holt Public Schools (HPS) follow that State and County guidelines for accepting and assigning indistrict and out of district school of choice students.

Our district as well as every school in our district has an active Improvement Plan with goals extending three years into the future.

Holt's Curriculum is driven by the State of Michigan curriculum standards and the National Common Core Curriculum. Access to our curriculum may be found on the district website, following the curriculum link. Additionally, curriculum maps are available in each building and widely distributed at school open houses.

We hope you take a few minutes to review this Annual Education Report and see what is happening at Holt Junior High School. Thank you to our entire school community for your continued support.
