



K-12 Athletic and Non-Athletic Participation Fees

- Pay to Participate allows us to maintain the current level of sports and extracurricular programming. These are District fee schedules and do not preclude individual groups or activities from charging additional fees.
- Students will only be charged once per year for Athletics (multi-sport athletes pay one athletic fee) and once per year for Non-Athletics. Students involved in both Athletics and Non-Athletics will pay two separate fees. Check the parent portal to determine whether fees have already been paid.
- All fees are non-refundable.
- To accommodate families with multiple students and students in multiple sports, the District offers payment-plan options. Please work with your building secretary to develop a payment plan as needed.
- Fees will be paid through FinalForms. Once teams and clubs are established and rosters are finalized, families will be notified about the payment process.
- Unpaid Pay to Participate fees will result in students being unable to play or perform. All fees must be paid before the first date of competition.

Total Family Cap
