Box Tops for Education

Clip Box Tops from participating products and send them in with your child or drop them in the collection box outside the office. Sign up on the BTFE website to receive their newsletter which earns bonus box tops and watch your email for promotions to win even more box tops for the school. Elliott Elementary earns 10¢ for each box top.



Campbell's Labels for Education

Clip the entire UPC code on participating products from the Campbell's family of products and send to school with your child or drop them in the collection box outside the office. Elliott Elementary earns points for each label, which can be used to purchase equipment for the school. Kroger Plus Card users can visit www.elabelsforeducation.com to enroll and link your Plus Card to Elliott Elementary. When you purchase Campbell's products and use your Plus Card the labels will automatically be counted. No more cutting!



Aunt Millie's School Spirit Program

It's easy! All you have to do is clip out and save the UPC codes on the bottom of the bread bags. Send them in with your child or drop them in the collection box outside the office. When we collect and turn them in, Aunt Millie's will pay us a nickel for every UPC. Eligible Aunt Millie's, Holsum, Snack Planet, Soft 'N Good and Sunbeam products will be specially-marked with the School Spirit symbol proof-of-purchase symbol (UPCs) on their bag.



Tyson's Project A+

Just clip and collect Tyson Project A+ labels from packages of participating Tyson products and send them to school with your child or drop them in the collection box outside the office. We'll collect the labels and send them to Tyson Foods, and Tyson Foods will send our school a check. Each label is worth 24¢!



Funding Factory

Then simply use your Meijer Credit Card or pay with cash or your PIN-based debit card with your swiped Meijer 1 Card whenever you shop at Meijer. Elliott will automatically receive a percentage of your purchase totals, with double the rewards when you use your linked Meijer Credit Card!
