Holt Public Schools plans to return to five days of in-person instruction for all TK-12 students this August 2021. In classrooms where 3ft physical distancing is not possible, desk shields will be used. Desk shields will be used in the cafeteria. If needed, masks will be available on each bus and at each school for students and staff.
